Subject: Coyote and Bobcat Hunting

O R D E R

Unlawful to hunt coyotes or bobcats EXCEPT when another season is open to hunting. They may be hunted in daylight hours only, EXCEPT when hunting fur-bearing animals at night during fur-bearer season. Unlawful to use shotguns with rifled slugs or shot larger than #4's or rifles or pistols larger than .22 caliber rimfire at night. EXCEPTION: Coyotes and bobcats may be taken with steel traps under Section 35.04 or with a permit issued under Section 100.19.

PENALTY: \$25.00 to \$250.00


Subject: Horsepower of Outboard Motors

O R D E R

Amends Code Book Section 71.05 (Item #1)

1. The use of any motor in excess of 10 horsepower is prohibited.  
(Exceptions: Party Barges may use up to and including 25 horsepower and authorized commercial boat docks will be required to have an emergency boat with sufficient horsepower to answer any emergency that might arise, regardless of lake conditions.)  
The 10 horsepower restriction shall not apply to Lake Enterprise, Upper Lake Chicot and Grand Lake.



AMENDMENT #2 - Code Book Section 55.04

MINNOW AND SHAD TACKLE RESTRICTIONS. Unlawful to use seines, nets, traps, dips or lifts for taking minnows or (shad for fish bait) from the public waters of this State without said tackle conforming to the following specifications and restrictions: Seines, traps, dips or lifts must be of 1/4 inch wire or mesh; EXCEPT SHAD TRAWL NETS WHICH MAY BE UP TO ONE (1) INCH SQUARE BAR MESH. Trap throats must be covered with one inch square mesh; maximum size of any square trap, dip or lift shall be six feet by six feet by three feet deep; maximum size of any circular trap shall be three feet by three feet; maximum size of any plastic or glass trap shall be less than one gallon; maximum size of any seine shall be twenty feet by four feet; maximum size of any throw net, casting net, or shad trawl net shall not exceed six feet in diameter; traps must be run at least once a day; no seine, dip, lift, throw nets, or shad trawl net shall be used at night (EXCEPT hand operated dip nets, lifts, or nets UP TO ONE (1) INCH SQUARE BAR MESH may be used to take legal bait for personal use only while in the act of sport fishing at night with artificial light); all fish except carp (minnow family), gar, grindle, shad or green sunfish must be carefully and immediately returned to the waters where taken.

AMENDS CODE BOOK SECTION 150.00

O R D E R

GAME FISH LIMITS. Unlawful to take more than the daily limit of any species of game fish, and a daily limit shall be allowed for a calendar day, or midnight until midnight.

Daily limits are as follows with exceptions noted below:

Black Bass -----	10	Trout -----	6
Crappie -----	20	Walleye -----	6
Catfish (other than bullhead) -	10	Northern Pike -----	6
White Bass -----	25	Pickereel -----	6
Bream -----	50	Muskellunge -----	6
Goggle-Eye -----	50	Striped Bass(imported ocean variety)	6
Sunfish, or any Perch -----	50	Sauger -----	6

Not more than 75 game fish in the aggregate may be taken during one day and two days catch may be possessed except when fishing or returning from a one day fishing trip.

EXCEPTIONS: The crappie limit between the main levees of the Mississippi River shall be 50 with a possession limit of 100. There will be no catfish limit between the main levees of the Mississippi River. There will be no limit on white bass taken from Beaver Reservoir.

Lake Lou Emma	Crawford County
Crowley Ridge State Park Lake	Greene County
Spring Lake	Yell County
Lake Sylvia	Perry County
Craighead County Forest Lake	Craighead County
Lake Bentonville	Benton County
Shady Lake	Polk County


The daily black bass limit on the following waters shall be 5:

Lake Bentonville	Benton County

EXCEPTION: only 1/2 the daily game fish limits shall be allowed under Section 51.02 in areas open to spearfishing.






