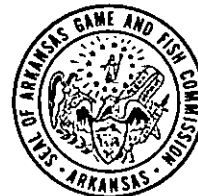

Subject: Depredation Permits

O R D E R

AMENDS CODE BOOK SECTION 100.19

Unlawful for anyone to kill protected wild animals or wild birds allegedly doing damage to his crops or property without a permit issued by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission.

The owner, or his tenant, of the property damaged shall notify (in writing) the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission or its representative of the damage being done; giving the location of the property being damaged, the nature of the damage and the species doing the damage.

If it is determined that substantial damage is being done and efforts to divert or repel the animals fail, a permit for ten (10) days MAY be issued.

In the event an animal (other than small game) is killed under a permit issued by the Commission, the Wildlife Officer must be notified immediately. The permittee shall not move any animals killed, unless given permission to do so by an Arkansas Game and Fish Commission representative.

The permittee shall return his permit to the Wildlife Officer with the required information as to the animals killed at the end of the ten (10) day period.

PENALTY: \$25.00 - \$250.00
