O R D E R

Unlawful for any person, 16 years of age and older, to hunt, take, or attempt to take by any means whatsoever any wild animal or wild bird in this State without first procuring a current and valid Arkansas hunting license. Persons who do not qualify as residents must obtain a nonresident hunting license and in addition it shall be unlawful for any nonresident person, 16 years of age or older, to hunt deer or turkey in this State without first obtaining a current and valid Arkansas nonresident deer or turkey tag, as the case may be, and a basic nonresident hunting license.


A NONRESIDENT BUYING A BASIC NONRESIDENT HUNTING LICENSE PLUS A DEER TAG MAY USE THE DEER TAG FOR HUNTING DEER IN ANY LEGAL MANNER.

Nonresidents killing a deer or turkey shall immediately fill out the correct tag thereby invalidating the tag and shall not hunt the species further without first obtaining another valid tag. No nonresident shall obtain for his own use, more deer or turkey tags than the number of the species allowed in the seasonal bag limit. It is further provided that a nonresident person under 16 years of age shall, upon killing a deer or turkey, immediately purchase a basic nonresident license and the correct nonresident deer or turkey tag and invalidate tag by filling out and attaching the tag to the kill. (Hunting license not required for persons under 16 years of age, except nonresidents killing deer or turkey.)

PENALTY: Nonresidents - \$100.00 to \$300.00  
Residents - \$ 25.00 to \$250.00


Unlawful to hunt crows, EXCEPT from February 1 to April 30, and from June 1 to July 5. (All dates inclusive) Shotguns with rifled slugs or shot larger than #4's and rifles or pistols larger than .22 caliber long rifle rimfire are prohibited for crow hunting.

EXCEPTION: Crows may be killed when found committing or about to commit depredations upon ornamental or shade trees, agricultural crops, livestock, or wildlife, or when concentrated in such numbers and manner as to constitute a health hazard or other public nuisance. No permit required.

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$500.00



ORDER

The exterior boundaries of each commercial shooting resort shall be clearly defined and posted with signs erected around the extremities at intervals of 300 feet or less and bearing the words, "Commercial Shooting Resort." On any day, before hunting is allowed on a shooting resort, the person or persons operating the resort must release at least as many game birds as the number of birds intended to be harvested that day less the number of birds released the previous hunt that were not harvested. The owner, operator, or manager of a commercial shooting resort shall be required to handle and issue shooting permits in the name of the Commission, and before issuing a license or permit, first file with the Commission an acceptable bond in an amount sufficient to cover all funds collected by the owner, operator, or manager for license or permit fees. ALL ACREAGE IN THE SHOOTING RESORT WILL BE CONTIGUOUS AND NOT EXCEED 1,500 ACRES.





Subject: Wearing Fluorescent Blaze  
Orange "Hunter Orange"

ORDER

It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any type of game animal or game bird "except waterfowl" during a lawful gun deer season in this state unless such person is wearing an outer garment above the waistline of fluorescent blaze orange (hunter orange) or bright red color totaling at least 400 square inches of clothing and must be worn conspicuously on the person. This regulation shall also apply to any person accompanying, aiding or assisting another person to hunt or pursue deer. Provided, however, that the provisions of this regulation shall not apply to persons hunting in areas in this state in which the hunting of deer with guns is prohibited by regulation of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, it being the intent of this regulation to apply to all areas of the state where it is lawful to hunt deer with guns during deer seasons. The provisions of this regulation shall equally apply to any special deer hunting seasons in areas in which hunting deer is limited to special permits issued by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. Effective July 1, 1976 the words "bright red color" will be deleted from this regulation then only fluorescent blaze orange color will be lawful.


O R D E R

Unlawful to kill, shoot at, maim or wound a buck deer unless at least one antler is a hardened bone antler and at least 4 inches long or forked EXCEPT in areas or seasons opened to the taking of antlerless deer by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. It shall be unlawful to possess or transport the carcass of any buck deer without a hardened bone antler of at least 4 inches or forked in areas not open to the taking of antlerless deer unless said deer was legally killed and checked in an area opened to the taking of antlerless deer by the Commission, or deer was legally taken in another state.

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$500.00



However, their pelts may not be taken or sold outside the regular fur-bearing season.

Unlawful for any person, 16 years of age and older, to hunt, take, or attempt to take by any means whatsoever any wild animal or wild bird in this State without first procuring a current and valid Arkansas hunting license. Persons who do not qualify as residents must obtain a nonresident hunting license and in addition it shall be unlawful for any nonresident person, 16 years of age or older, to hunt deer or turkey in this State without first obtaining a current and valid Arkansas nonresident deer or turkey tag, as the case may be, and a basic nonresident hunting license.



It is further provided that a nonresident person under 16 years of age shall, upon killing a deer or turkey, immediately purchase a basic nonresident license and the correct nonresident deer or turkey tag and invalidate tag by filling out and attaching the tag to the kill. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any type of game animal or game bird "except waterfowl" during a lawful gun deer season in this state unless such person is wearing an outer garment above the waistline of fluorescent blaze orange (hunter orange) or bright red color totaling at least 400 square inches of clothing and must be worn conspicuously on the person. This regulation shall also apply to any person accompanying, aiding or assisting another person to hunt or pursue deer. Provided, however, that the provisions of this regulation shall not apply to persons hunting in areas in this state in which the hunting of deer with guns is prohibited by regulation of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, it being the intent of this regulation to apply to all areas of the state where it is lawful to hunt deer with guns during deer seasons. The provisions of this regulation shall equally apply to any special deer hunting seasons in areas in which hunting deer is limited to special permits issued by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. Effective July 1, 1976 the words "bright red color" will be deleted from this regulation then only fluorescent blaze orange color will be lawful.

Unlawful to kill, shoot at, maim or wound a buck deer unless at least one antler is a hardened bone antler and at least 4 inches long or forked EXCEPT in areas or seasons opened to the taking of antlerless deer by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. It shall be unlawful to possess or transport the carcass of any buck deer without a hardened bone antler of at least 4 inches or forked in areas not open to the taking of antlerless deer unless said deer was legally killed and checked in an area opened to the taking of antlerless deer by the Commission, or deer was legally taken in another state.

However, their pelts may not be taken or sold outside the regular fur-bearing season.
