
COMMISSION CODE BOOK SECTION 60.31

Sale of Commercial Fishes: It shall be unlawful to sell commercial species of fish unless the seller possesses a current, annual Commercial Fisherman Permit, a Fish Farmer's Permit or Put-and-Take Pay Lake Permit. A bill of sale is required for each transaction of sale to markets, processors, or retailers, and the Permit number shall be placed on each bill of sale. The bill of sale shall be retained by the purchaser for twelve months and made available to employees of this agency upon request. This section does not apply to retail sales of processed fish (prepared for cooking or to sales for immediate consumption (restaurants).

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$500.00.

Purchase of Wild Commercial Fishes: Unlawful to purchase non-processed commercial fishes for resale unless the seller holds a Commercial Fisherman Permit, a Fish Farmer's Permit or a Put-and-Take Pay Lake Permit. Permit number is required on all bills of sale. The bill of sale shall be retained by the purchaser for twelve months and made available to employees of this agency upon request. This does not apply to establishments which prepare and sell fish for immediate consumption on the premises (restaurants).

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$500.00.

O R D E R

AMENDS CODE BOOK SECTION 150.00 AND COMMISSION ORDER 016-75

GAME FISH LIMITS Unlawful to take more than the daily limit of any species of game fish, and a daily limit shall be allowed for a calendar day, or midnight until midnight.

Daily limits are as follows with exceptions noted below:

Black Bass-----	10	Trout-----	6
Rock Bass-----	10	Walleye-----	6
Crappie-----	20	Northern Pike-----	6
Catfish (other than bullhead)-----	10	Pickrel-----	6
* White Bass-----	25	Muskellunge-----	6
** Bream-----	50	Striped Bass including Striped Bass hybrids any combination-----	6
		Sauger-----	6

Not more than 75 game fish in the aggregate may be taken during one day and two days catch may be possessed except when fishing or returning from a one day fishing trip.

EXCEPTIONS: The crappie limit between the main levees of the Mississippi River shall be with a possession limit of 100. There will be no catfish limit between the main levees of the Mississippi River.

- \* There will be no limit on white bass taken from Beaver Reservoir and all tributaries above Beaver Dam including Lake Sequoyah.
- \*\* Bream is defined as any species of the genus Lepomis to include bluegill, redear, goggle-eye, sunfish or "perch"; no limit on bream four inches or less in length.

EXCEPTION: Only 1/2 the daily game fish limits shall be allowed under Section 51.02 in areas open to spearfishing.

AMENDS COMMISSION CODE BOOK 40.01

Unlawful for any person 16 years of age and older to fish in any manner whatsoever or to take or attempt to take frogs, minnows or mussels in this State without first procuring a current and valid fishing license issued by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission except as provided in Section 60.03. Persons who do not qualify as residents must purchase a current and valid non-resident fishing license before fishing, taking or attempting to take frogs, minnows, or mussels in Arkansas. No fishing license shall be required to fish in Pay Lakes licensed by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. (Fishing license not required for persons under 16 years of age.)

PANALTY: Residents \$25.00 to \$250.00.  
Non-residents \$25.00 to \$250.00.

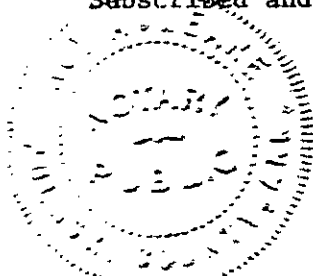



Noodling and Snagging: Unlawful to noodle or snag any Game fish, except that fish may snagged in those waters within 100 yards downstream from a dam for personal use only and may not be sold. No game fish (including catfish) taken in this manner will be returned to the water but will apply against the daily bag limit.

PENALTY: \$25.00 to \$250.00.

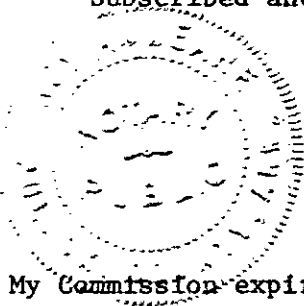



Fishing Below Dams: Unlawful to fish within 100 yards below any dam in any manner except with one pole or rod and reel, held in hands, or bow and arrow except shad may be taken with hand-held dip net for personal use only (not for sale) as bait.

PENALTY: \$25.00 to \$250.00.

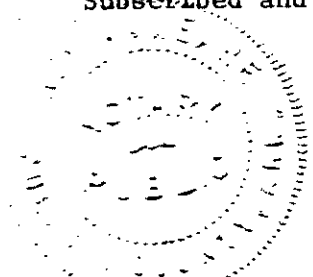

SEASONS AND MESH SIZES  
Subject: FOR NETS

O R D E R

AMENDS COMMISSION CODE BOOK 120.00 AND COMMISSION ORDER 022-74

Seasons and Mesh Sizes for Nets: MINIMUM MESH SIZES MEASURED WHEN MESH IS WET AND/OR TREATED WITH PRESERVATIVE. Hoop Nets, Wings, Leads, or Heart and Leads: Minimum Mesh size, 2½ inches. Fish seines: minimum mesh size, 3 inches.

Three (3) inch bar mesh gill and trammel nets may be used day and night, for commercial purposes only, from October 1 through April 30. EXCEPTIONS: Three (3) inch bar mesh gill and trammel nets may be used day and night for commercial purposes only, the entire year, on the following streams only: Red River, Little River from its mouth to within 100 yards of Millwood Dam; Ouachita River up to the mouth of Little Missouri River; Fourche LaFave from its mouth to Highway 7 Bridge; Petit Jean River from its mouth to Highway 10 Bridge at Danville; White River up to the mouth of Salado Creek; Black River up to the mouth of Spring River; and Saint Francis River up to the mouth of the left-hand chute of Little River. Such fishing is permitted within the normal banks of these streams, and includes any lake, bay, or other body of water, except tributary streams, when they are accessible by boat from the main channel.

Three (3) inch bar mesh gill and trammel nets may be used day and night, for commercial purposes only, the entire year, in Arkansas waters between the main levees of the Mississippi River and all lakes through which the state line may traverse. Said mesh size to be measured after the nets have been treated with preservative or when wet.

All navigational pools including channel scar lakes, bays or other backwaters, except tributary streams, which are accessible by boat from the navigational channel at the established navigational pool elevations on the Arkansas River from Lock No. 2 and Dam No. 2 upstream to the Highway 7 bridge may be fished the year around with gill and trammel nets having no smaller than (3½) three and one-half inch bar mesh. All navigational pools including all channel scar lakes, bays or other backwaters, except tributary streams, which are accessible by boat from the navigation channel at the established navigational pool elevation on the Arkansas River above the Dardanelle Dam to the Oklahoma line may be fished with gill and trammel nets with no smaller than (3½) three and one-half inch bar mesh, EXCEPT the use of gill and trammel nets are prohibited in this area from March 1 through May 31. No commercial fishing is permitted on the following waters on Lake Dardanelle; those waters north of the Missouri Pacific Railway in Pope, Johnson and Franklin Counties and south of signs placed on Dardanelle Bay, Shoal Bay, Cane Creek Bay and south of Highway 22 in Delaware Bay.

Gill and trammel nets may be fished in the Arkansas River below the Morgan Cut-Off to the Mississippi River year around, with bar mesh sizes not less than (3) three inches. No commercial fishing is permitted in 100 yards below any lock and dam.

The use of seines or nets other than as provided for in this regulation is prohibited except under special permits.

Sale of Game Fish: It shall be unlawful to sell, or possess for sale any game fish other than catfish in this State except that bream, four inches and less in length, may be sold as fish bait by persons licensed to do so by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. This regulation shall not apply to fish from waters covered by a fish farmer license.

PENALTY: \$50.00 to \$500.00.



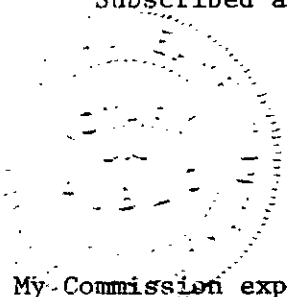

WATERS CLOSED TO COMMERCIAL FISHING. No Commercial fishing is permitted in the following counties or parts of counties: Baxter; Benton; Boone; Carroll; Clark, west of highway 67 from Arkadelphia south to county line and west of highway 7 from Arkadelphia north to county line; Cleburne; Conway, north of Interstate 40, except Cadron Creek and the part of the north Cadron Creek in Conway County, and Point Remove Creek up the east fork to highway 95 and the Kissire Bridge on the west fork; Crawford, north of Interstate 40 and highway 64 except that part of the North Cadron Creek in Faulkner County below highway 285, and the Cadron Creek in Faulkner County; Franklin, north of the Missouri Pacific Railroad and east of highway 23, and that part north of Interstate 40 and west of highway 23; Fulton, west of highway 63; Garland, west of highway 7; Hempstead, north of highway 24; Hot Spring, west of highway 7; Howard, north of highway 24; Independence, west of highway 167; Izard; Johnson, north of the southern route of the Missouri Pacific Railroad EXCEPT Dardanelle Lake; Logan, south of highway 10; Madison; Marion; Montgomery; Nevada, north of highway 24 and west of highway 67; Newton; Perry, west of highway 7; Pike; Polk; Pope, north of Interstate 40 and east of highway 7, and north of the Missouri Pacific Railroad and west of highway 7 EXCEPT Dardanelle Lake; Scott; Searcy; Sebastian, south of highway 10; Sevier, north of highway 24; Sharp, west of highway 167 and highway 62; Stone; Van Buren; Washington; White, north of highway 64 and west of highway 167; Yell, west of highway 7 and south of highway 10.

In addition no commercial fishing is permitted in any of the following waters: All waters upstream from 100 yards below Rempel Dam on the Ouachita River (this includes Lakes Catherine and Hamilton); Lake Erling including all tributaries upstream from 100 yards below the Lake Erling Dam to Arkansas State Highway 82; all lakes owned and/or operated by the State Parks, Recreation and Travel Commission, the U. S. Forest Service, the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission (excluding Grand Lake and all of Lake Chicot); Lake Kate Adams, Big Jefferson and Minne Anderson; and Lake Wallace in Drew and Chicot Counties; Lake Maumelle in Pulaski County, and all lakes in the Hot Springs Village area of Garland and Saline Counties. The preceding named waters shall remain closed to all commercial fishing until changed by Order of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. IF ANY of these waters are temporarily opened to commercial fishing they shall return to a closed condition at the end of the specified open period.
