Unlawful to take or attempt to take deer with .410 gauge shotguns using any ammunition other than rifled slugs; with any shotgun using shot smaller than number 4 buckshot; with rifles using rimfire cartridges, military, or solid metal cased ammunition; with pistols having barrels less than 4 inches in length or pistols capable of firing any ammunition other than ammunition that may be legally used in rifles.



TRAP RESTRICTIONS. Unlawful for any person to use, set, construct, possess (in fields or woods), or tend any steel trap, in this State, except smooth-jawed steel traps with a jaw spread not larger than 5 5/8", except that traps with a jaw spread of up to 5 7/8" with smooth jaws and Conibear traps may be used in water sets in trapping for beaver. Any trap with a jaw spread greater than 5" must have offset jaws. No traps so used shall be set in any path, trail or runway commonly used by persons, domestic animals, poultry or dogs. And provided further that any steel trap set for the purpose of catching any fur-bearing animal shall be visited at least once each day and any catch therein removed therefrom. Provided nothing in this paragraph shall prevent persons duly authorized in writing by the Commission from possessing and using traps with a jaw spread not larger than 5 7/8" for use in taking coyotes, and other nuisance animals.

Unlawful to use, set or run any trap or snare outside the legal furbearer trapping season, except smooth-jawed, offset jaw traps with a jaw spread up to 5 7/8" in land sets, and (Conibear traps in water sets only) may be used by landowner or controller to protect their property against damage that is occurring. The landowner or controller may also give other persons permission (on a form furnished by the Commission) to trap the above-described lands. Persons, other than the landowner or controller, trapping under the above Section must have valid Arkansas hunting and trapping licenses. Any harmless or non-depredating bird or animal which may be caught must be immediately released unharmed.

\*Warning signs furnished by the Commission must be erected in a conspicuous location when using traps with a jaw spread greater than 5 5/8". It shall be unlawful to use any trap for the purpose of this Section with a jaw spread greater than 5 7/8".



However, their pelts may not be taken outside the regular fur-bearing season.

ORDER

COYOTE HUNTING. Coyotes may be hunted only during other open hunting seasons in daylight hours only, EXCEPT they may be taken at night during fur-bearing season when legally hunting fur-bearers. Unlawful to use shotguns with rifled slugs or shot larger than No. 4 common shot (No. 4 common shot .13 inches in diameter) or rifles or pistols using ammunition larger than .22 caliber rimfire rifle any time when coyote hunting EXCEPT during open gun deer seasons. The use of dogs for coyote hunting during spring turkey and spring squirrel seasons is prohibited. EXCEPTION: A person owning or controlling lands can possess and use on such lands any type or size firearm (daylight hours only) and such owner or controller can, on a standard form supplied by the Commission, give permission to a tenant, employee or neighbor to shoot coyotes on his lands using any size or type firearm, provided that such person would be required to have a current hunting license on his person. Coyotes may be taken with steel traps under Section 35.04 or with permit issued under Section 100.19 of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Code Book.

COYOTE HUNTING. Coyotes may be hunted only during other open hunting seasons in daylight hours only, EXCEPT they may be taken at night during fur-bearing season when legally hunting fur-bearers. Unlawful to use shotguns with rifled slugs or shot larger than No. 4 common shot (No. 4 common shot .13 inches in diameter) or rifles or pistols using ammunition larger than .22 caliber rimfire rifle any time when coyote hunting EXCEPT during open gun deer seasons. The use of dogs for coyote hunting during spring turkey and spring squirrel seasons is prohibited. EXCEPTION: A person owning or controlling lands can possess and use on such lands any type or size firearm (daylight hours only) and such owner or controller can, on a standard form supplied by the Commission, give permission to a tenant, employee or neighbor to shoot coyotes on his lands using any size or type firearm, provided that such person would be required to have a current hunting license on his person. Coyotes may be taken with steel traps under Section 35.04 or with permit issued under Section 100.19 of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Code Book.

TRAP RESTRICTIONS. Unlawful for any person to use, set, construct, possess (in fields or woods), or tend any steel trap, in this State, except smooth-jawed steel traps with a jaw spread not larger than 5 5/8", except that traps with a jaw spread of up to 5 7/8" with smooth jaws and Conibear traps may be used in water sets in trapping for beaver. Any trap with a jaw spread greater than 5" must have offset jaws. No traps so used shall be set in any path, trail or runway commonly used by persons, domestic animals, poultry or dogs. And provided further that any steel trap set for the purpose of catching any fur-bearing animal shall be visited at least once each day and any catch therein removed therefrom. Provided nothing in this paragraph shall prevent persons duly authorized in writing by the Commission from possessing and using traps with a jaw spread not larger than 5 7/8" for use in taking coyotes, and other nuisance animals.

Unlawful to use, set or run any trap or snare outside the legal furbearer trapping season, except smooth-jawed, offset jaw traps with a jaw spread up to 5 7/8" in land sets, and (Conibear traps in water sets only) may be used by landowner or controller to protect their property against damage that is occurring. The landowner or controller may also give other persons permission (on a form furnished by the Commission) to trap the above-described lands. Persons, other than the landowner or controller, trapping under the above Section must have valid Arkansas hunting and trapping licenses. Any harmless or non-depredating bird or animal which may be caught must be immediately released unharmed.

\*Warning signs furnished by the Commission must be erected in a conspicuous location when using traps with a jaw spread greater than 5 5/8". It shall be unlawful to use any trap for the purpose of this Section with a jaw spread greater than 5 7/8".




