

O R D E R

LOADED FIREARMS ON ROADS DURING GUN DEER SEASONS. It shall be unlawful to possess any loaded firearm which is legal for deer hunting within 50 feet of the center line of any maintained or improved road which is open to public vehicular travel during any regular deer season. (Does not apply to permit muzzle-loading deer hunts). Maintained or improved roads shall be roads which have been either, paved, gravelled, ditched, graded or received other visible maintenance.

Firearms shall be considered to be loaded if shells or cartridges are in either the chamber, magazine or cylinder. Percussion cap muzzle-loading firearms are considered to be unloaded if the percussion cap is not on the nipple. Flintlock muzzle-loading firearms are considered to be unloaded if there is not any powder in the flash pan.

ORDER

FUR DEALER REPORTS. Unlawful for fur dealers to fail to keep an itemized list of furs they purchase and to completely fill out the fur dealer report forms furnished by the Commission. The list must be brought up to date each day furs are purchased. The list shall be made immediately available for inspection to Commission employees upon request. The fur dealer report shall be given to a Commission employee no later than thirty days following the close of regular fur bearing season.

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$500.00 Fur dealers failing to comply with this regulation shall not be sold a fur dealer license the next year.



PETS. It shall be lawful to take from the wild, raccoon, opossum, squirrels, rabbits, deer, bobcat, quail eggs and coyotes and keep in captivity as pets. It shall be unlawful to take these species for pets in any manner except with hands, and they or their progeny may not be sold or transported from the state. No permit is needed for taking or keeping said species for pets.




ORDER

MUZZLE-LOADING FIREARMS. Unlawful to hunt deer during the Special Permit Muzzle-loading Firearm Hunt except in designated areas with only muzzle-loading firearms fired by flintlock or percussion cap, and with a bore not smaller than forty caliber (.40) firing a single ball, slug or projectile. Muzzle-loading weapons with iron sights only may be used. A Special Muzzle-loading Permit is required; in addition all persons, 16 years of age or older, are required to have a Resident or Non-Resident Basic Hunting License (whichever is appropriate, see Section 40.02).





No metal objects may be screwed or driven into trees. Portable tree stands must have the owner's name and address permanently affixed. Portable tree stands may not be left in place for more than seven (7) days, and must be removed on the last day of archery deer and turkey seasons.




