ORDER

LOADED FIREARMS ON ROADS DURING GUN DEER SEASONS. It shall be unlawful to possess any loaded firearm which is legal for deer hunting within 50 feet of the center line of any road which is city, county or state owned or maintained during any regular gun deer season. (Does not apply to permit muzzle-loading deer hunts.)

Firearms shall be considered to be loaded if shells or cartridges are in either the chamber, magazine or cylinder. Percussion cap muzzle-loading firearms are considered to be unloaded if the percussion cap is not on the nipple. Flintlock muzzle-loading firearms are considered to be unloaded if there is not any powder in the flash pan.

PENALTY: \$25.00 to \$250.00.

O R D E R

LOADED FIREARMS ON ROADS DURING GUN DEER SEASONS.
