ORDER

NUISANCE TRAPPING. Unlawful to use, set, or run any trap or snare outside the fur-bearer trapping season except landowners or controllers, to protect their property against damage that is occurring, may use the following traps only:

- a) In land sets, smooth jawed steel traps with a jaw spread up to and including 6½" (if jaw spread is greater than 5", trap must have offset jaws). 110 or 120 Conibear traps or comparable traps with a jaw spread up to and including 4½" or live traps.
- b) In water sets, smooth jawed steel traps with a jaw spread up to and including 7¼", and Conibear traps or comparable traps with a jaw spread up to and including 10".

The landowner or controller may also give other persons permission (on a form furnished by the Commission) to trap the above-described lands. Persons, other than the landowner or controller trapping under this Section, must have a valid hunting license and a Fur Takers Permit. Any harmless or non-predatory bird or animal which may be caught must be immediately released.

*Warning signs, furnished by the Commission, must be posted by the landowner or trapper in a conspicuous location when using traps with a jaw spread greater than 5 5/8" in land sets.

PENALTY: \$50.00 to \$300.00
