MUZZLE-LOADING PERMIT DEER HUNTS.

- (A) An Arkansas muzzle-loading deer permit is required of all muzzle-loading season deer hunters regardless of age. In addition, all muzzle-loading hunters, 16 years of age or older, are required to have a valid Arkansas hunting license.
- (B) Prohibited Muzzle-Loading Season Firearms.
- (1) Firearms not loaded through the muzzle.
 - (2) Firearms converted from cartridge type weapons.
 - (3) Firearms not using flint or percussion caps to ignite powder.
 - (4) Firearms with barrels less than 18 inches in length.
 - (5) Firearms firing other than a single projectile.
 - (6) Firearms of less than .40 caliber.
 - (7) Firearms equipped with scope sights.
- (C) It shall be unlawful to have in immediate possession a centerfire or rimfire weapon while participating in muzzle-loading permit deer hunts.

MUZZLE-LOADING PERMIT DEER HUNTS.

- (A) An Arkansas muzzle-loading deer permit is required of all muzzle-loading season deer hunters regardless of age. In addition, all muzzle-loading hunters, 16 years of age or older, are required to have a valid Arkansas hunting license.
- (B) Prohibited Muzzle-Loading Season Firearms.
- (1) Firearms not loaded through the muzzle.
 - (2) Firearms converted from cartridge type weapons.
 - (3) Firearms not using flint or percussion caps to ignite powder.
 - (4) Firearms with barrels less than 18 inches in length.
 - (5) Firearms firing other than a single projectile.
 - (6) Firearms of less than .40 caliber.
 - (7) Firearms equipped with scope sights.
- (C) It shall be unlawful to have in immediate possession a centerfire or rimfire weapon while participating in muzzle-loading permit deer hunts.
