ORDER

POSSESSION OF FURS. It shall be unlawful to possess, sell or offer for sale the pelt of any fur-bearing animal after the 15th day following the close of fur-bearing season.

Exceptions:

- (1) Beaver, muskrat and nutria pelts may be possessed or disposed of at any time.
- (2) A properly licensed fur dealer having an established place of business in the state shall be allowed 25 days following the close of fur-bearing season.
- (3) A fur-dealer may obtain an extension by submitting to the Commission, within 25 days following the close of fur-bearing season, an application accompanied by an inventory indicating number and kind of pelts on hand.

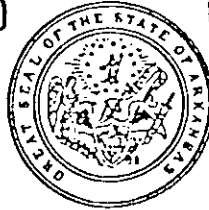

POSSESSION OF FURS. It shall be unlawful to possess, sell or offer for sale the pelt of any fur-bearing animal after the 15th day following the close of fur-bearing season.

Exceptions:

- (2) A properly licensed fur dealer having an established place of business in the state shall be allowed 25 days following the close of fur-bearing season.
- (3) A fur-dealer may obtain an extension by submitting to the Commission, within 25 days following the close of fur-bearing season, an application accompanied by an inventory indicating number and kind of pelts on hand.

ORDER

FUR TAKER'S PERMIT REQUIREMENTS: It shall be unlawful for any person of any age to take, attempt to take, or possess fur-bearing animals or any part thereof without first procuring the appropriate current fur taker's permit.

Exceptions:

1. Persons taking nuisance fur-bearing animals outside the open fur-bearing season.
2. Landowners or controllers taking nuisance fur-bearing animals on their own land during fur-bearing season, if pelts are not sold.
3. Persons obtaining carcasses of legally taken fur-bears.

PENALTY: \$25.00 to \$250.00 (Resident)
\$100.00 to \$300.00 (Non-resident)

FUR TAKER'S PERMIT REQUIREMENTS: It shall be unlawful for any person of any age to take, attempt to take, or possess fur-bearing animals or any part thereof without first procuring the appropriate current fur taker's permit.

Exceptions:

1. Persons taking nuisance fur-bearing animals outside the open fur-bearing season.
2. Landowners or controllers taking nuisance fur-bearing animals on their own land during fur-bearing season, if pelts are not sold.
3. Persons obtaining carcasses of legally taken fur-bears.

PENALTY: \$25.00 to \$250.00 (Resident)
\$100.00 to \$300.00 (Non-resident)





1980-81 FUR-BEARING ANIMAL SEASONS. It shall be unlawful to take or attempt to take any animals designated as fur-bearing animals or animals designated as nuisance fur-bearing animals anytime, other than the declared seasons for the taking of such animals or as otherwise provided for in this section.

Fur-bearing animal seasons (Badger, beaver, bobcat, civet cat, coyote, gray fox, mink, muskrat, nutria, opossum, raccoon, river otter, skunk and weasel):

Raccoon Hunting Season - Noon, November 20, 1980 - Noon, November 29, 1980.

Fur-bearer Hunting Season - Noon, November 29, 1980 - January 21, 1981.

Fur-bearer Trapping Season - Noon, November 29, 1980 - January 31, 1981.

EXCEPTIONS:

A. Nuisance fur-bearing animals (Beaver, muskrat and nutria)

1. Taken the entire year by trapping.
2. Taken the entire year with firearms in daylight hours only.
3. Taken with firearms at night only in accordance with Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Code Section 100.19, Depredation Permit.
4. Taken in accordance with Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Code Section 35.04, Nuisance Animal Control Permit.
5. Taken when in the act of committing damage to personal property.

Raccoon Hunting Season - Noon, November 20, 1980 - Noon, November 29, 1980.

Fur-bearer Hunting Season - Noon, November 29, 1980 - January 21, 1981.

Fur-bearer Trapping Season - Noon, November 29, 1980 - January 31, 1981.

EXCEPTIONS:

1. Taken the entire year by trapping.
2. Taken the entire year with firearms in daylight hours only.


