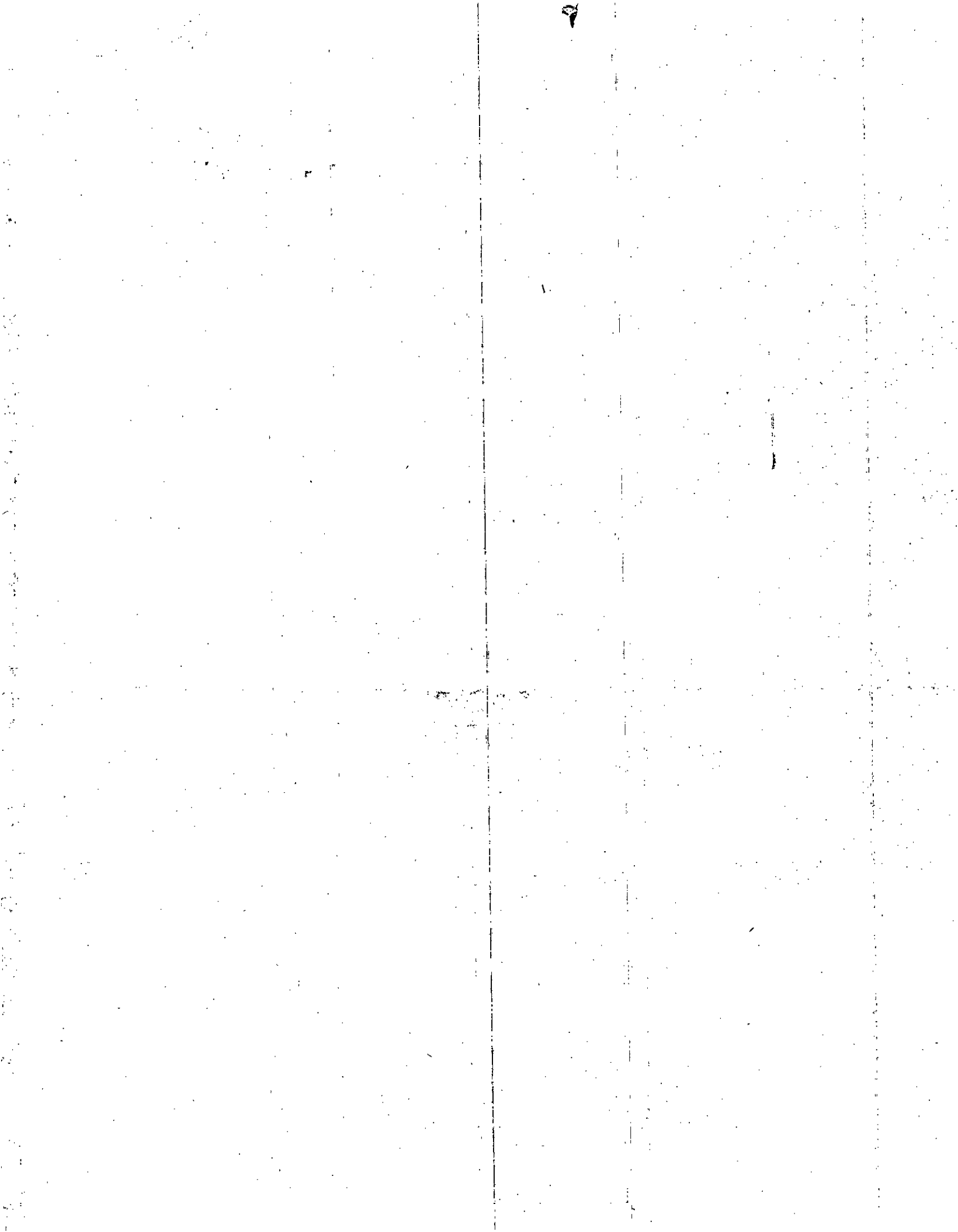

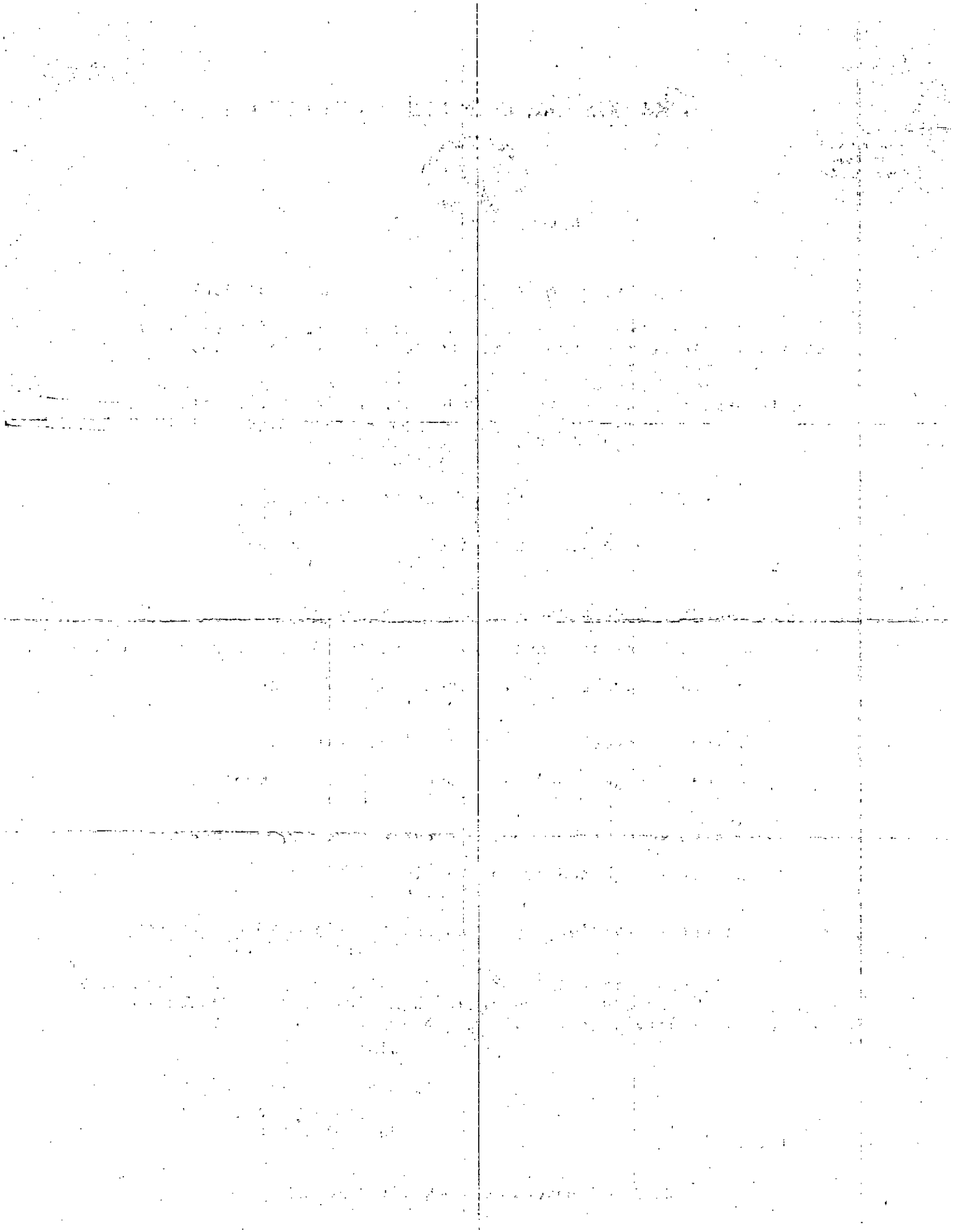

PENALTY: \$200.00 to \$500.00.

(B) Rifles or pistols larger than .22 caliber.

EXCEPTIONS:

- (1) Coyote, Rabbit and Squirrel during open gun deer seasons.
(2) Crow during open gun deer seasons when gun deer season dates include portions of crow season.

PENALTY: \$50.00 to \$300.00.

**GAME ANIMAL DAILY BAG LIMIT AND
POSSESSION RESTRICTIONS.**

It shall be unlawful to take or attempt to take more than the daily bag limit of any game species set forth by the Commission as specified herein: (Ref: Section 01.00-C Bag Limit). The possession limit shall not exceed two (2) daily bag limits or as otherwise specified herein:

(A) Deer

- (1) Individual limit of two (2) deer with modern firearms for all combined regular gun deer seasons; or
- (2) Individual limit of two (2) deer with muzzleloader, for all combined deer seasons; or
- (3) Individual limit of three (3) deer with archery/crossbow for all combined deer seasons; or
- (4) Individual limit of three (3) deer provided at least one (1) of the three is taken with archery, crossbow or muzzleloader.

Daily bag limit 8, Possession

(C) Rabbit:

Daily bag limit 8, Possession
limit 16.

(D) Raccoon:

No daily bag limit.

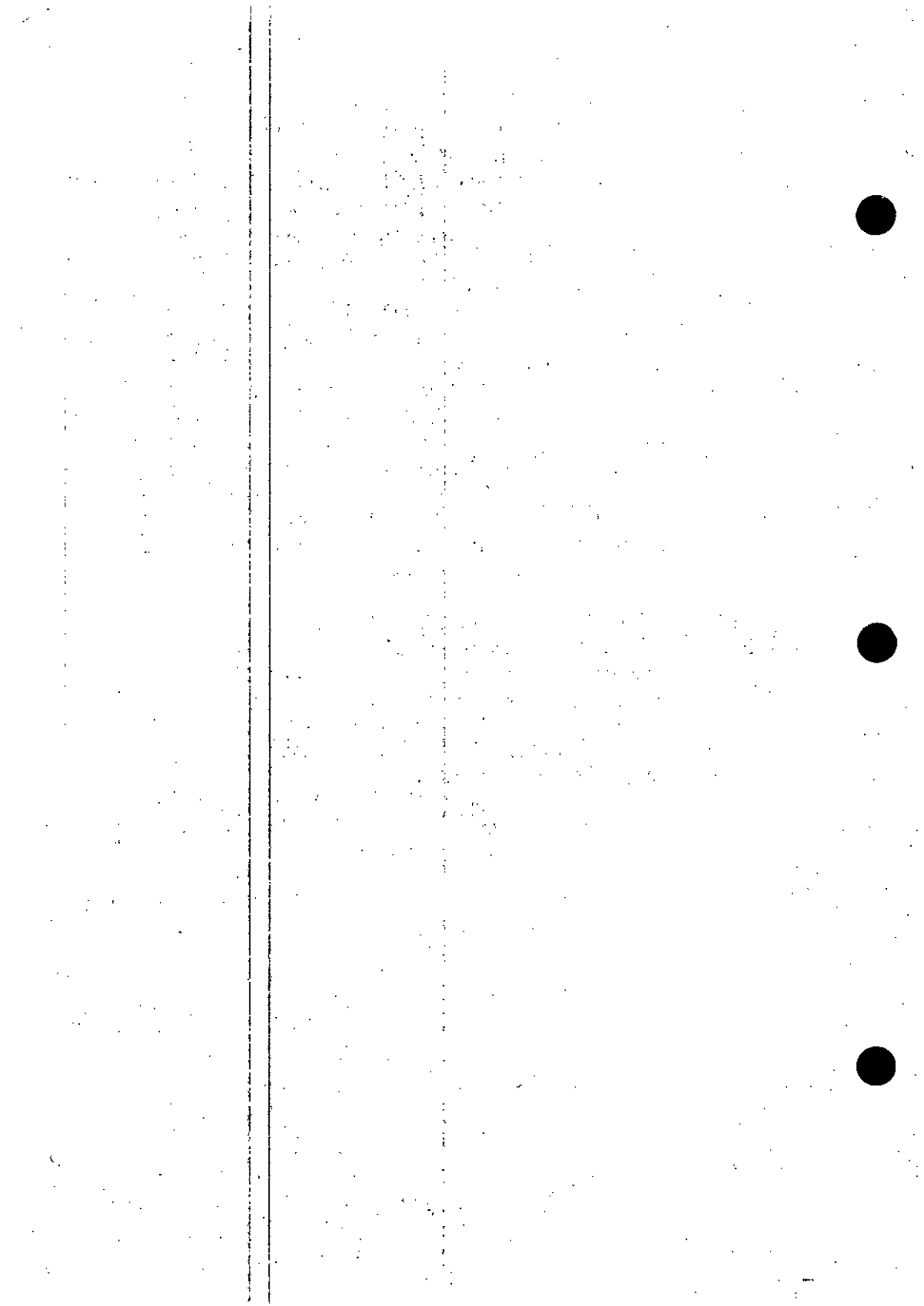

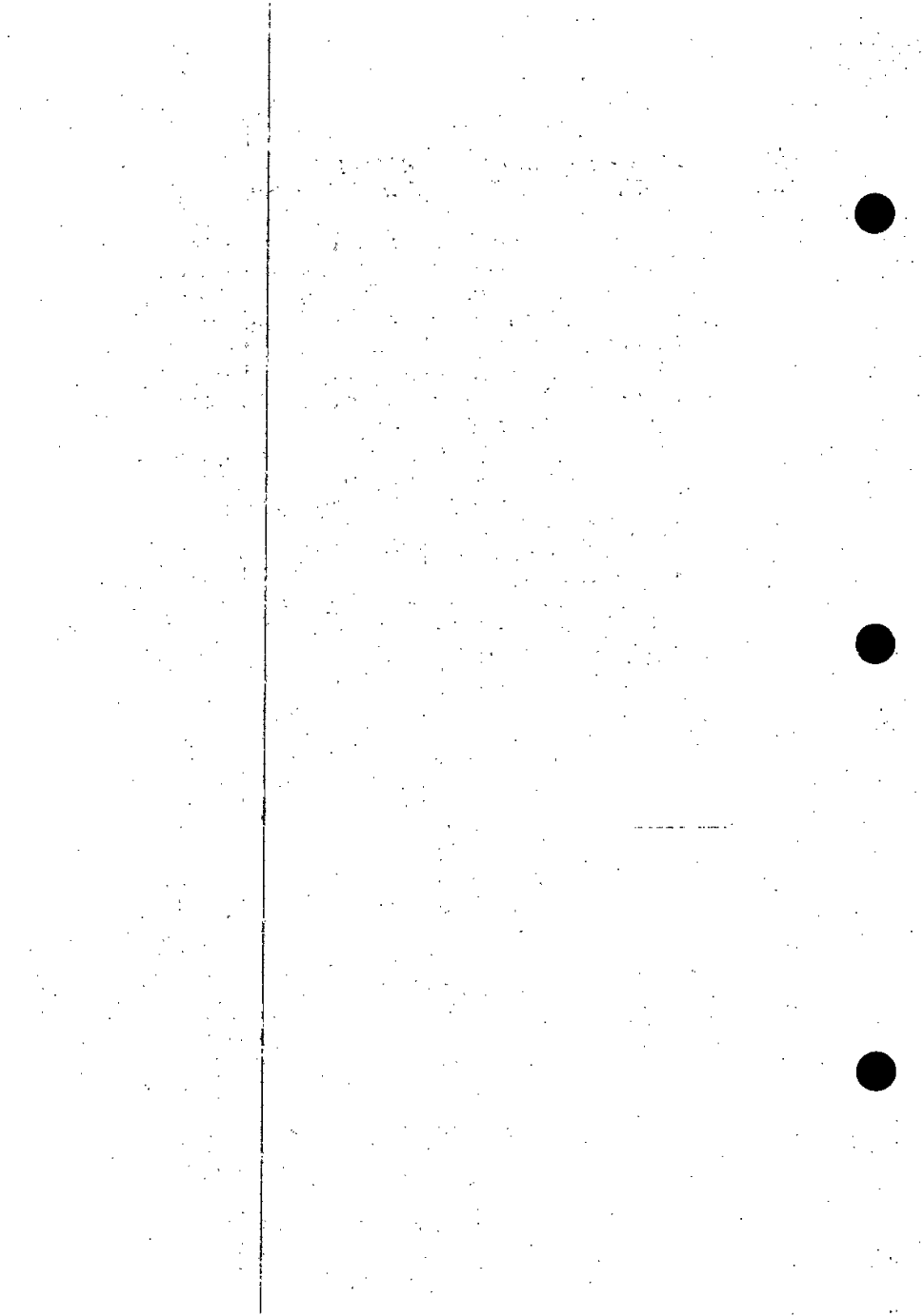

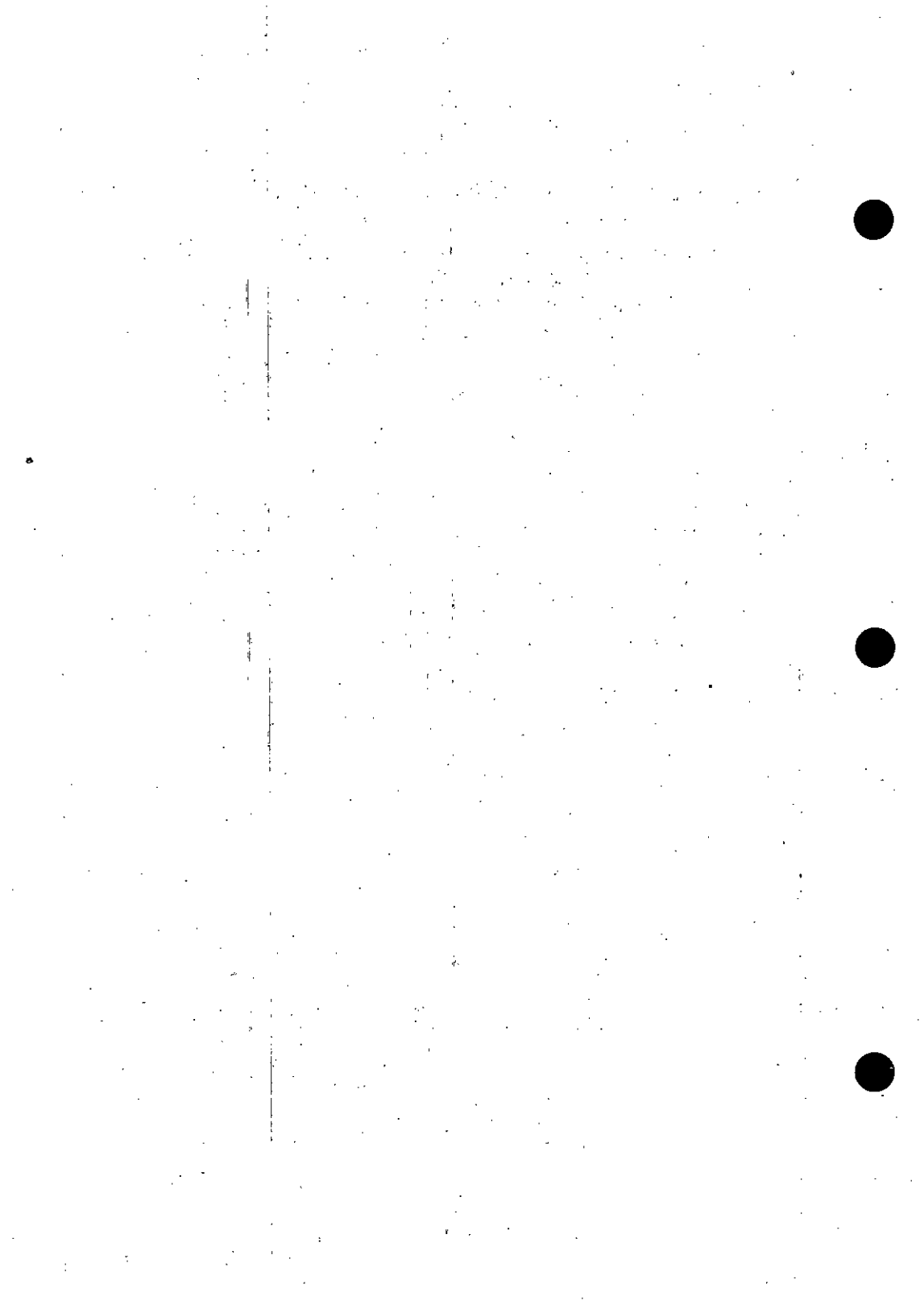

EXCEPTIONS:

- (1) Migratory waterfowl hunting permitted during the entire day (regular shooting hours) of the last three (3) days of the last migratory waterfowl season. Ref: Commission Code 12.13.
- (2) Temple Island within Bayou Meto WMA closed to all types of hunting except waterfowl during waterfowl seasons.
- (3) *Harris Brake WMA open to waterfowl hunting only Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays of the migratory waterfowl season with migratory waterfowl hunting permitted the entire day the last three (3) days of the last waterfowl season.*
