Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA) Section 106 (b)(2)(B)(xxiv), (b)(2)(B)(xxv)	During the first two years of continuous employment as a PCSA caseworker	Approved human trafficking training listed within the statewide LMS
5153.125 5153.127	Every two years	1) Individual Training Needs Assessment (ITNA) 2) Individual Development Plan (IDP) The ITNA and the IDP are to be jointly completed in the statewide LMS by the caseworker and the caseworker's supervisor
