

Attachment A- STM Restrictions Scale

*Restrictions based on managing an AIC in relation to their current management plan, pertinent behavioral concerns, or any potential threat to the safety, security, orderly, or efficient operation of any Department of Corrections prison, institution, facility, program, or activity. The suspension, restriction, or modification of programs or services provided to an AIC shall be based on the following guidelines for timeframes and approval authority:*

Restrictions which <u>do not impose actual limitations on programs or services offered to an AIC but instead establish timeframes and expectations for behavioral goals</u> to be achieved by the individual as part of their management plan.	7-90 Days	Current STM Lieutenant
First Restriction	7-14 Days	Current STM Lieutenant
Second or Third Restriction	14-45 Days	STM Lieutenant to which the AIC is not currently assigned
Fourth or Fifth Restriction	45-60 Days	STM Lieutenant to which the AIC is not currently assigned
Sixth or beyond	60-90 Days	Inspector General or Assistant Inspector General
Specific circumstances that, in the judgment and discretion of the Inspector General or an Assistant Inspector General, warrant an immediate and substantial response without regard to the number of prior restrictions (e.g., modification of mail services based on introduction of contraband, restriction on cell moves, etc.)	180 Days	Inspector General or Assistant Inspector General
