Excision of malignant tumor	Severe oral and facial injuries
Incision and drainage of abscess	Treatment by approved Level I and II nursing protocols
Emergency tracheotomy	Treatment of pain
Treatment of Osteomyelitis	Treatment of oral abscesses and infections
Mandibular fractures (open and closed reductions)	Dislocated mandible
Maxillary fractures (open and closed reductions)	Hemorrhage
Fractures of facial bones

Palliative Treatment	Diagnostic Treatment
Sedative fillings	Inside consults
Pain medication	Dental X-rays
Antibiotic therapy	Bacteriological cultures
Prescription of any medication in the Pharmacy formulary	Biopsies
Treatment of pulpitis	Preventive Treatment
Removal of necrotic teeth	Oral hygiene instructions
Treatment of gingival sensitivity	Access to care instructions
All local anesthetic procedures	Oral exam and dental history screening
Operative Treatment	Periodic dental exams
Temporary restorations	Removal of calculus
Amalgam restorations	Acute gingivitis treatment
Resin restorations	Acute periodontal treatment
Stainless steel crowns	Acrylic partial denture repairs
Resin crowns	Cast partial denture repairs
Prosthetic Treatment	Full denture repairs
Any cases that may be exceptions may be submitted to TLD for consideration.	Relines (lab and chair side)
Conventional maxillary and mandibular dentures – Minimum 2 year sentence	Tissue conditioner (for existing dental prosthesis)
	Stabilization of loose teeth
	Reimplantation if appropriate

Extractions	Removal of root tips
Removal of cysts and abscesses	Treatment for infections
Removal of foreign bodies	Alveoplasty
Fistula drains and closures	Sutures
Treatment for dry sockets	Any other post-surgical treatments

LEVEL 3	
TMJ splints	Occlusal Guards
All outside referrals including treatment for the following conditions: a) Removal of impacted wisdom teeth (third molars) b) Osseous Surgery c) Periodontal Procedures d) Oral pathology consultations and treatment (non-emergent) e) TMJ consults and/or treatment	Removal of pre-existing tooth fragments or foreign bodies (not painful or progressive)
	Facial prostheses due to injuries
	Physical Therapy
	All Cast partial dentures – 2 year sentence requirement
	Repairs of pre-existing facial fractures

Obturator appliances	Sealants
Frenectomies	

LEVEL 4	
Fixed bridgework	Custom laboratory crowns
Cosmetic crown repair	Inlays/Onlays
Oral implants of any kind	Orthodontic procedures
Surgical repositioning of teeth	TMJ surgery
Cosmetic surgery	Teeth whitening procedures
Immediate upper or lower dentures	Any prosthetic treatment determined to be predominately cosmetic in nature
Any endodontic procedures (root canal treatment)	Prosthetic treatment for patients having adequate occlusion (Generally described as 10 or more teeth in occlusion)
IV sedation for routine dental treatment, including surgery or operatives
