(1) A <u>bachelor</u> [ <del>bachelor's</del> ] degree with 12 college credit hours in child development and six college credit hours in management[ <del>7</del> ]	and at least one year of experience in a licensed child-care center;
(2) An <u>associate</u> [ <del>associate's</del> ] of applied science degree in child development or a closely related field with six college credit hours in child development and six college credit hours in management. A "closely related field" is any educational instruction pertaining to the growth, development, physical or mental care, or education of children ages birth through 13 years[ <del>7</del> ]	and at least two years of experience in a licensed child-care center;
(3) Sixty college credit hours with nine college credit hours in child development and six college credit hours in management[ <del>7</del> ]	and at least two years of experience in a licensed child-care center;
(4) A child-care administrator's certificate from a community college with at least 15 college credit hours in child development and three college credit hours in management[ <del>7</del> ]	and at least two years of experience in a licensed child-care center;
(5) <u>Six college credit hours in management with a</u> [ <del>A</del> ] Child Development Associate credential or Certified Child-Care Professional credential [ <del>with six college credit hours in management,</del> ]	and at least two years of experience in a licensed child-care center;
(6) A day-care administrator's credential issued by a professional organization or educational institution and approved by Licensing based on criteria specified in Subchapter P of Chapter 745 of this title[ <del>7</del> ] (relating to Day-Care Administrator's Credential Program)[ <del>7</del> ]	and at least two years of experience in a licensed child-care center; or
