(1) Short personal restraint	May not be exceeded.
(2) Personal restraint	May not be exceeded.
(3) Emergency medication	Not applicable.
(4) Seclusion	May be exceeded if the caregiver obtains a written continuation order before the end of the time period from the licensed psychiatrist, psychologist, or physician with written clinical justification: (A) Indicating that the emergency situation continues to exist; and (B) For the length of time the psychiatrist, psychologist, or physician permits the child to be secluded, which must not exceed four hours.
(5) Mechanical restraint	May be exceeded if the caregiver obtains a written continuation order before the end of the time period from the licensed psychiatrist with written clinical justification: (A) Indicating that the emergency situation continues to exist; and (B) For the length of time the psychiatrist permits the child to be restrained, which must not exceed four hours.
