The formula for estimating turnout for the ~~2014~~ joint primary elections is:

$$(A \times B) + C + D = E$$

Where:

A = the percentage of voter turnout for the office that received the most votes in the most recent comparable ~~2010~~-party primary election (percentage is the sum of all votes cast for the office that received the most votes in the most recent comparable party ~~2010~~ primary election divided by the number of registered voters).

B = the number of registered voters as of October preceding the primary ~~2013~~.

C = 25% of the number resulting when you multiply A x B.

D = Other party's estimated turnout figure.

E = Preliminary Estimated ~~2014~~ Turnout for Joint-Primary Election.
